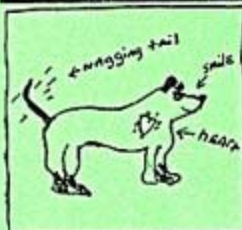

HARLEY'S HOUSE

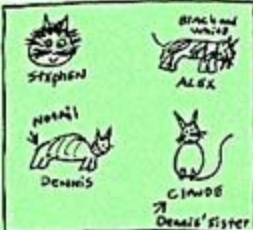

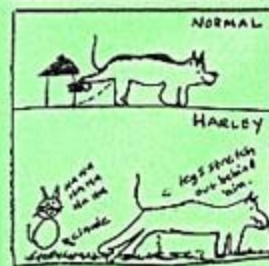

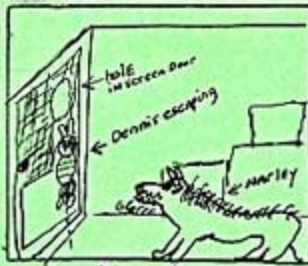
These are Harley's cats. They all pretend to hate each other when people are around - but they love each other. They chew on things together. They go dancing too!



Harley and DENNIS DANCING....






Harley's mother did not teach him to pee right. He is learning from other dogs now. The cats make fun of him...
